Then just thirtyy minutes North is another wildlife refuge. Wait a minute! The gate to that



# Destination, three Redwood State Parks close to Crescent City, CA.

Weather permitting this is the most common time to catch rhododendrons in bloom among redwood, but no guarantees.

Jedediah Smith Redwoods State Park http://www.parks.ca.gov/?page\_id=413 Not many rhodies, nice hikes, big redwoods. Approx. 6 mi. (10 km) No. of Crescent City Del Norte Coast Redwoods State Park http://www.parks.ca.gov/?page\_id=414

Several trails may have rhododendrons in bloom, with fog possible in redwoods.

Approx. 10 mi. (16 km), So. of Crescent City. Prairie Creek Redwoods State Park http://www.parks.ca.gov/?page\_id=415 Large trees, many trails, rhodies, Gold Bluffs Beach & Fern Canyon. Cal Barrel Rd on a ridge

with photo shoots right from road. Park, shoot, drive another \( \frac{1}{4} \) mile, rinse and repeat. Prairie Creek St. Pk. Visitors Center 32 mi. (51 km) So. of Crescent City. Sat. restaurant lunch to compare notes. Restaurant dinner gathering, Sun. night.


